Each ASL vet has their own payment arrangements - they are not interchangeable - so it is worth contacting yours first to see how they accept payment.

To register your pet you will need:

1. Your PET(s)
2. ORIGINAL rabies certificates (if available)
3. Proof of payment
4. The completed registration form
5. Your codice fiscale
6. Your passport
7. Proof of address - lease, bill, etc. (this is not always checked/requested at the ASL)



If your pet is already registered and you just need a pet passport you will need:

1. Your PET(s)
2. ORIGINAL rabies certificates
3. Proof of payment

You will need to make an appointment with the vet before you go there - they don't accept drop-in clients at the time of writing (30.03.2021).

Don't worry about not being able to make yourself understood; you can request an appointment by email and they will respond to you in English!
