


It's not every day you will get to see a flock of sheep making their way through the city of Madrid!

COVID19 INFORMATION

GENERAL MEASURES

Hotels, restaurants, cinemas, theatres and casinos must close by 0100 and sports facilities and gyms to close by 0000. Nightclubs are now open until 0300. Masks no longer need to be worn outdoors, however are still compulsory indoors.

PRIVATE GATHERINGS AND EVENTS

Social gatherings in Hotels and restaurants is still 6 per table indoors and 8 per table outdoors, face masks still need to be worn continuously unless taking food or drink.

AREA RESTRICTIONS

You can now travel to any area within Spain. However, some regional and local areas are still enforcing curfews. Please check before travelling -

TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS

Travel from the UK to Spain will require either a negative PCR or antigen test taken less than 72hrs prior to travel

or proof of full vaccination. You also need to complete a health control form for all the family inc children under 12, for more information see the link - www.spth.gob.es

If travelling from Spain to the UK and you are fully vaccinated you need to provide proof of a negative PCR/Antigen/LAMP test take within 3 days of travelling, complete a passenger locator form within 48hrs of travel, and book and take a day 2 (these need to be booked

prior to travel). Children under 4yrs do not need to take the day 2 test. Go to www.gov.uk for more information. The next travel review is
