Foreword by Wg Cdr Machin

The death of Her Majesty the Queen was an occasion of profound sadness, and a cause for reflection and thanks. The reaction across the United Kingdom and around the world reflected the very deep respect, admiration and affection felt for Her Majesty. As President Macron said, 'To you she was your Queen, to us she was The Queen'. For all of us here in Ramstein, and for most of the nation, she was - in a reign of 70 years - the only Monarch we had known.

And for seventy years, she was our Commander-in-Chief. Her own wartime service and experience in the Auxiliary Transport Service provided much of the values that epitomised her reign: duty, responsibility, courage, determination, and sacrifice. It created an easy and exceptionally deep bond with all who serve and served in the Armed Forces, including her children and her grandchildren. And she was keenly interested in her Royal Air Force and Commonwealth Air Forces, visiting stations and units around the world throughout her reign - with a husband, son and grandson all earning their Wings, her bonds with the Service were highly personal too.

Her Majesty's dedication and steadfastness saw the nation through challenging decades: from the rebuilding and renewal after the collective sacrifice of nation and empire during World War 2 to a United Kingdom and Commonwealth that looks both very different yet still easily recognisable seventy years later. She provided a sure foundation - above politics and fashions - around which to come together, in hard times and in the good. She was, quite simply, a remarkable woman.

As this truly historic month has drawn to a close, the sense of sorrow and of thanks towards Her Majesty the Queen is still keenly felt across our community. Despite the very sad occasion, it was heart-warming to see so many of us gathered to pay our respects to our Commander in Chief in a moment of reflection on the evening before Her funeral. It also showed the true nature of our NATO Alliance, and what the suffering of one member means to our friends. Not only did our community receive an outpouring of condolences and support, but our friends joined us in our reflection and mourning. The strength of NATO rests in its unity and occasions like this show our Alliance in the light that makes us the bastion of freedom in Europe.

God save the King.

Whilst he has made a notable point of informing everyone he is going to a place he calls 'PACOM', in reality, he is being posted to the Hawaiian Golf Society, which happens to have a US facility conveniently next door, with a small office for his personal belongings (Golf clubs). Before he leaves us for the beaches and Mai Tai's of Hawaii, he will be presented with the NATO Meritorious Service Medal, which Air Cdre Hill previously recommended him for in recognition for his outstanding contribution and dedication to NATO, whilst representing the RAF at HQ AIRCOM. We wish all the best to the Harding family in Hawaii and for the future, and thank you for everything you have done for us within the community.





9-11th Dec 2022



## JOB VACANCIES Brit Shop Assistant

Applications are invited for the following Brit Shop Casual Assistant positions x 2.

The shift patterns will be 0900-1330 or 1330-1800.

The positions are to cover staff sickness and holidays. Occasional Saturday mornings will be required too between the hours of 1000-1430.

The current hourly rate for Brit Shop Assistants is €13.23

The Brit Shop Assistant duties will include:

- Ensuring that all customers are eligible to shop and ensuring those customers are served efficiently and politely
- b) The handling of cash.
- Operating the computer system and associated stock control systems, credit card machines and cash registers in accordance with standard operating procedures.
- d) Undertaking administrative tasks, including interaction with SAF accounts staff, essential for the efficient running of the Brit Shop.
- e) Physically moving heavy stock items\* from delivery vehicles to and from stock rooms and onto shelves.
- f) When requested by the Brit Shop Manager, the escorting of delivery vehicles from the LVIS Gate of Ramstein AB to the Brit Shop and return, therefore a full driver's license is required.
- g) Maintaining the shop in a presentable state, to include general cleaning duties and the disposal of rubbish/trash.

This position is open to all UK dependants and spouses of US/NATO personnel who are aged over 18 years and hold SOFA status, however in line with the Service Amenities Fund constitution preference will be given to applications from within the UK military community. Terms of employment will be broadly governed by the employment laws of England and Wales.
